## Savannah Bar Association's Guest Policies

## **EVENING SOCIAL EVENTS:**

Each active SBA member (annual dues paid) may bring ONE free guest to each of the following evening social gatherings (unless notification is given that children are also invited, in which case they too will be free):

- a) The Oyster Roast
- b) The Barbecue
- c) The End of the Year Cocktail Party

The guest may be one of the member's choosing, other than a practicing lawyer in Savannah (unless the guest is married to the SBA member).

Registration is required for all members and guests for evening social events. If an SBA member wishes to bring a non-member lawyer who practices in Savannah or more than one guest, then the member must pay the per-person cost of the event for each added guest. The SBA Treasurer will be able to inform the SBA member of the per-person guest fee before the event.

## **LUNCHEONS:**

An active SBA member may register a guest for a luncheon, including an attorney who practices in Savannah (who has never been an SBA member). However, the SBA member must pay the per-person guest fee of the luncheon. Non-member attorney guests will then have a chance to "sample" the Savannah Bar Association to decide if they would like to join. Once someone has joined the Savannah Bar Association, they may attend the luncheons only upon continued active status (annual dues paid). Registration for both SBA members and guests is required for all luncheons.

## **BOAT RIDE:**

An active SBA member (annual dues paid) may only bring guests who are practicing attorneys in locales other than Savannah/Chatham County and must register with payment and pay the guest fee upon registering (both fees are much reduced from the actual per-person cost of the boat ride).

All SBA guest fees/boat ride registration fees are non-refundable
